#### **BOOK-BANK**

This year we have extended the library services through the book-bank facility.

It is intended to provide useful reference books according to the syllabus to the student till the year end examinations. We started on a low key by providing 105 sets of books in FY B Com, 71 sets in SY B Com and 54 sets in TY B Com.

#### **EDUCATION** with IT

We installed 20 computers in the Library to offer IT environment for the student community. As the Vision and Mission statement of SPB implies that we value the modern approach of learning methods in this information age. Our students are eager to be computer literate and techno-savvy. It is a great experience to see these young SPBians blossoming into multifaceted and multi task handlers in a short span. #### 31. Student achievements and awards

In the area of academic activities, once again our students performed very well in the University examinations. At the last University convocation held on 26fh Feb.-2011, Ms Riddhi Jain of our college was awarded Shri Ashwin Mehta Prize and Manngalya Medal for securing highest marks at T. Y. B. Com. Examination 2010 and Shri C. C. Sopariwala Prize for securing highest marks in Auditing and Mgt Accounting as Special subject at B.

College also bagged gold medal in boxing tournament. The college won 2 prizes/awards in inter collegiate sports tournament and tournaments organised as part of Swarnim Gujarat. College also organised Inter College Table Tennis Tournament. Students bagged six gold medals in Swarnim Maha Kumbh. College bagged the runners up position in the tournament organized by Sarvajanik Education Society.

So far as cultural activities are concerned about 46 students and 9 teams of the college took part in various competitions of the annual cultural event of the University and won 2 prizes / awards in these competitions. One of the college students won the first prize in intercollegiate debate and elocution competition.

It is very heartening to note that more than 400 students of our college are pursuing, along with the B. Com. degree course, professional courses like CA, CS, ICWA, etc., Not only that many student of the college are also pursuing vocational courses related to computer and I.T., Fashion Designing, Gems & Jewelry Designing, etc. This year more than 150 students of T.Y. B.Com. have appeared in qualifying examinations like CAT, XAT, MAT, etc., for admission to management courses after their graduation, being offered by the institute of national and international repute like IIM, XLRI, SYMBIOSIS, NMIMS, NIRMA, etc., Two of our students received call for interview at IIM for interview for MBA admissions.
