

As we are aware that Goods and Services Tax (GST) which is a comprehensive tax on supply of goods or services or both, has been implemented from 1st July, 2017. This newly introduced Goods and Service Tax, subsumed all indirect taxes to create one rate and integrate the country into a single market and therefore it is regarded as the biggest tax reform that has taken place since 1947. So, it is very necessary to make students familiar with the GST and GST Accounting. Dr. Heena S.
