State Level Seminar: Direct Taxes Code - 2009

The College organized a State Level Seminar on 14th Nov. 2009 to orient and update the Academicians and the professionals about the Direct Tax Code and its effects.

The seminar was highly successful event with more than two hundred participants from all over the state. Dr A.K.Singh the Chief Commissioner of Income Tax delivered the key note address highlighting the, "Difference between the Current Income Tax Law and the Proposed Direct Tax Code".

Technical experts delivered their address on various aspects of Direct Tax Code-09. Chartered Accountant Shri R.N. Veparidiscussed at length the **Background and Strategy of Direct Tax Code**. Chartered Accountant Shri Saurin Shah spoke on Significant Changes Impacting Computation and Taxation of Companies and Wealth Tax, Chartered Accountant Shri Hiren Diwanspoke on Direct Tax Code for Non Profit Organization and Chartered Accountant Shri Keyur Mehta spoke on Penalty Prosecution and Special Provision to Prevent Evasion in Direct Tax Code.

There was a lot of deliberation amongst the learned faculty and subject experts on the new tax-code. It was an enlightening experience. A compact disc containing all the available materials on Direct Taxes Code-2009 was distributed to participants.

A seminar on Corporate Social Responsibility

It was for awareness about Corporate Social Responsibility among students and public. The seminar was funded by Ministry of Corporate Affairs. It was organised by Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Government of India and Surat South Gujarat Chapter of Cost Accountants of WIRC of ICWAI in association with our college on 19th December 2009.

- ➤ Group photos of the winning teams at various competitions are given to all participants and a copy of the same is displayed on the college notice-board to boost the morale of the participants.
- ➤ Inter-class tournaments are organized in Volley Ball, Cricket, Chess, Badminton, Table Tennis, Football and Athletics every year and prizes are given on the sports day to the winners.
- ➤ Every year Prize Distribution function is held in the presence of Invitees, Faculty Members and Students and prizes and awards are given to all students who excel in academics, sports, cultural and other co-curricular activities .The function is followed by dinner for all.

31. Student achievements and awards

In the area of academic activities, once again our students performed very well in the University examinations. At the last University convocation held on 26fh Feb.-2010, Miss Divya Choudhary of our college was awarded Manngalya Medal for securing highest marks at T. Y. B. Com. Examination and another prize viz.Miss Shilpa Singhal was awarded silver medals for securing highest marks in the subject of Accountancy and Auditing.---- was awarded medal for securing highest marks in merchantile law.

As usual, during this year too, a number of our students have performed creditably in sports and as many as 14 students of the college have found places in various sports teams of Veer Narmad South Gujarat University, Surat, to play at national level in inter University Tournaments. Our college bagged the championship in Table Tennis Women's, Basketball men's and Football men's and the college Table tennis men's team became runners up at VNSGU inter college tournament. College also bagged gold medal in boxing tournament. The college won 4 prizes/awards in inter collegiate sports tournament and tournaments organised as part of Swarnim Gujarat. College also organised Inter College Table Tennis Tournament.

So far as cultural activities are concerned about 46 students and 9 teams of the college took part in various competitions of the annual cultural event of the University and won 5 prizes / awards in these competitions. The one act play "Chir-Swayamwara" won second prize at State level in Swarnim Gujarat as well as university youth festival. Continuing the tradition, the college also organized, annual cultural event 'SPB FEST – 2010' on the campus, in which about 140 students took active part in various items to make it a very successful event.

It is very heartening to note that more than 400 students of our college are pursuing, along with the B. Com. degree course, professional courses like CA, CS, ICWA, etc., Not only that many student of the college are also pursuing vocational courses related to computer and I.T., Fashion Designing, Gems & Jewelry Designing, etc. This year more than 150 students of T.Y. B.Com. have appeared in qualifying examinations like CAT, XAT, MAT, etc., for admission to management courses after their graduation, being offered by the institute of national and international repute like IIM, XLRI, SYMBIOSIS, NMIMS, NIRMA, etc., Many of them are also planning to pursuing their higher studies in Foreign Universites.
