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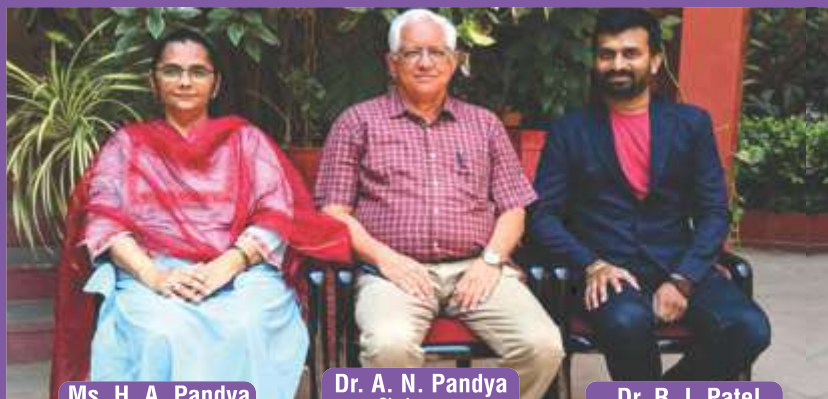

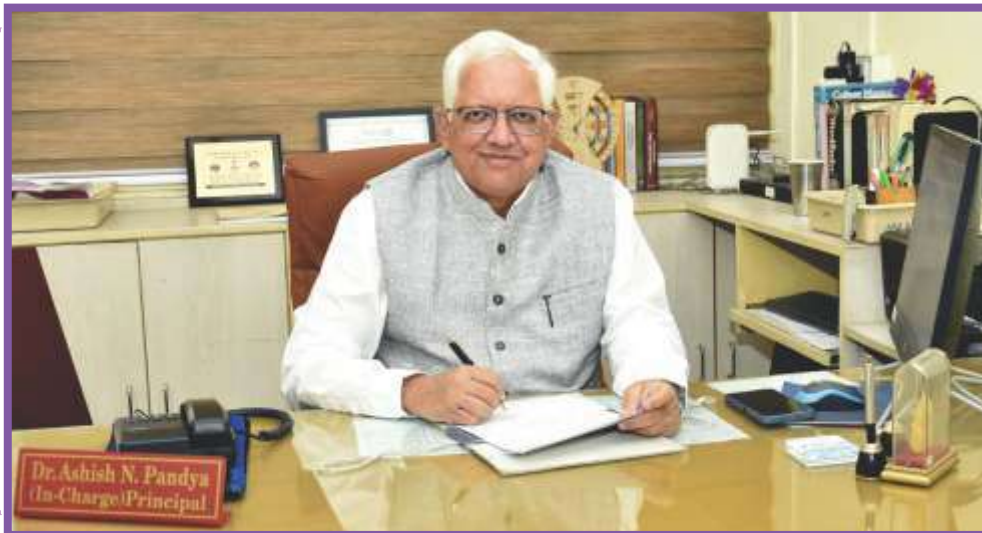

### From the Principal's Desk



Academic years 2022-24 witnessed a steady progression of the college on its journey towards excellence. With the implementation of NEP-2020 many reforms in academic framework/structure were introduced leading to changes in curriculum development and course planning. With emphasis on a holistic and multi disciplinary approach to education promoting the integration of arts, humanities, sports and vocational skills alongside academic subjects, NEP aims at overall development of students, fostering creativity, critical thinking and problem-solving skills. Adhering to the new educational norms certain changes were incorporated in the courses offered by our college with a view to encompass value based approach to teaching that creates a positive learning environment and enhances academic achievement.

At SPB we believe in complementing theoretical lessons with practical hands-on training. To enhance accounting skills of our students and make them more acceptable in a competitive job market, our college offers an add-on Tally Level-1 course. Under Finishing school Programme offered by the Knowledge Consortium of Gujarat, our students avail the opportunity of polishing their Soft Skills, Employability skills, Functional English Skills. This helps bridge the gap between industry and academia and helps students survive tough competition on the employability front. On-campus Placement Fair was organised this year for students seeking job opportunities after graduation/post-graduation in commerce.

On the academic front our college students have proved their mettle by scoring more





marks than the average university results. Our M.Com. student Ms. Sweta Vala was felicitated with Best Student Award by Sarvajani Education Society for her exceptional achievement in academics as well as in Debate and Elocution activities.

During the academic years 2022-24 our students as always have actively participated in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities and have won laurels for the college by way of winning championships and trophies at various Inter-college competitions at District, State as well as National level. I feel proud to mention that our Final year student Ms. Dhruvisha Jariwala secured IInd position in the final round of STRACTICAL - National Level Start up Competition organised by S.R. Luthra Institute of Management, Surat. Our second year student Ms. Isha Kapadia got selected for the State Level “Sanskrit Bhaskar” Examination organised by Bharatiya Sanskriti Gyan Pariksha, Haridwar.

Our students have enthusiastically participated in many intra- college as well as inter-college cultural activities and also represented our college at the University Youth Festival and bagged many prizes. I feel proud to say that our M.Com. student Mr. Dhruv Bulsara participated in Mono Acting at VNSGU Youth festival and got third prize in 2022-23 and consequently bagged second prize in Mono Acting in 2023-24.

On the sports front our students exhibit exemplary skills in a variety of games and many of them have been selected in the university team and have participated in Inter-university tournaments. Our students have represented our college in various sports at State, National and International level competitions.
