The course is designed to provide a hands on training along with the theoretical knowledge of Tally. On successful completion of this course, students are given an "add on" Tally course certificate which can increase the employability of student. A student, can also appear for Tally ACE certificate examination at the end of the course and can get a Merit Certificate from Tally Education Pvt. Ltd. This certificate enhances employability of a student in the field of accounting to a greater level.

The Twelth batch of Tally course was conducted during 1st August 2022 to 7th September 2022. 30 students were enrolled. All of these 30 students completed the course successfully. This batch secured 100% result.

The Eleventh batch of Tally course was conducted during 1st August 2022 to 30th August 2022. 19 students were enrolled. All of these 19 students completed the course successfully. This batch secured 100% result.

The Tenth batch of Tally course was conducted during 20th June 2022 to 23rd July 2022. 36 students were enrolled. All of these 36 students completed the course successfully. This batch secured 100% result.

The Ninth batch of Tally course was conducted during 3th March 2022 to 31st March 2022. 27 students were enrolled. All of these 27 students completed the course successfully. 25 students also appeared and cleared Tally Prime certificate examination. This batch secured 100% result.

In upcoming year 2024-25, we wish to conduct an advance Level-3 course of Tally for the benefit of the students.

Finishing School Programme

Development of Soft Skills and Communication Skills is imperative for students to increase their employability opportunities and to excel in their career domain. Finishing School is one such initiative by the Department of Education, Government of Gujarat under Knowledge Consortium of Gujarat (KCG) focusing on development of employability skills. Started in 2017 this government funded programme provides opportunity to students to enhance their Soft Skills and Employability Skills making them market ready in a very competitive world..

Finishing School has four Modules each of 20 hours. Component 1 and 2 (Employability and Life Skills) and Component 3 and 4 (Functional English and Communication Skills). It is an Employability enhancement initiative of the Education Department, Government of Gujarat for imparting training on skill development for students of Higher Education to make them Industry-ready.

Industrial Visit to KRIBHCO (Surat Plant)

Introduction: On March 5th, 2024, the Excursion Committee of SPB English Medium College of Commerce organized an industrial visit to the Krishak Bharati Cooperative Limited (Surat Plant). The visit aimed to provide students with practical insights into industrial operations, particularly in the field of production and dispatching.

He graciously introduced us to key personnel, including Mr. Jatinder Sondhi, General Manager of the Maintenance department, and Mr. Dinesh K. Patel, Mechanical Manager. Here, students gained insights into packaging techniques and the importance of efficient logistics management in meeting market demands.



We also visited the dispatching department, witnessing the seamless coordination of goods dispatch via railway for national distribution and trucks for local markets.

Lunch and Appreciation: Following the informative tour, students and faculty members were treated to a sumptuous lunch, arranged by the company. This provided an opportunity for further interaction and networking. Additionally, a group photo was taken with industrial personnel, commemorating the enriching experience.
